## **RESOLUTION 17R-16**

To request the RI Board to consider supporting ecologically-sustainable initiatives

WHEREAS, local efforts are needed by Rotary leaders and thought-shapers from 1 2 all over the world who are able to influence their own communities. Together, we commit with our actions to the common welfare to ensure sustainable 3 development, and 4 5 6 WHEREAS, human thinking about using resources linearly is not sustainable. 7 Similar to how nature itself does not produce rubbish or waste but, rather, reuses 8 resources, humans should strive to reach a level of consumption that does not expend natural resources, and 9 10 WHEREAS, "Less is more" design thinking should be encouraged to reduce waste 11 at all stages of product lifecycles, from initial creation of the product, during use, 12 and at the end. Recycling and reusing various types of materials throughout the 13 lifecycle can be increased with ecological product design, and 14 15 WHEREAS, end-of-life thinking is needed for products and materials to ensure 16 an ecologically clean process at the end of their useful life, to reuse valuable raw 17 18 materials, and to prevent potentially dangerous substances from escaping into nature. The Pacific Ocean garbage patch is a visible example of the consequence 19 of plastics being freely released into nature, and 20 21 WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase public awareness of sustainable solutions 22 in order to attain the goal of ensuring that the earth's natural resources will be 23 sufficient for generations to come, and 24 25 WHEREAS, by creating a sustainable initiative at the global level in Rotary, 26 27 involvement can be expanded to all current clubs, as well as future younger members, by showing that Rotary cares and wants to support important 28 29 initiatives for future generations 30 IT IS RESOLVED by Rotary International that the Board of Directors of Rotary 31 32 International consider giving attention and support towards ecologicallysustainable initiatives and programs, as well as aim to increase investment in 33 businesses that produce "clean" technology or improve the "circular economy." 34
