Our District 3181 now consists of revenue districts Dakshina Kannada, Kodagu, Mysore and Chamarajnagar. In fact this is the second year of District 3181.

At present there are only two cities in our District – Mangalore with about 15 clubs in and around and Mysore with about 16 clubs in and around. All other clubs are situated either in small towns or in mofussil areas.

There are 6 clubs which are mote than 50 years old.

As far as Madikeri club, home club of the Distrcet Governor is concerned, it is 70 years old. Our club has had two District Governors so far and the present Governor is the third from our club.

Main service areas of the clubs in the District are Community Service. Many of the clubs are running schools commencing from Kindergarten to High School level. Rotary Schools are popular Schools in the District.
